

Family Support Specialist

Position Summary:

Responsible for optimizing the home environment for the physical and mental well-being of children who are at risk of being abused or neglected, and their families. Assists with strengthening the parent-child relationship and meeting informational and other needs of parents. Works with individual clients in their home.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent required; Bachelor's degree in social work, psychology, sociology, child development, or a directly related field preferred
- Experience and demonstrated maturity in successfully raising and/or working with infants and young children
- Ability to attend and complete mandatory Healthy Families training during first year and ongoing training as required by State
- Availability to work varied shifts, including evenings, weekends, and occasional holidays, required
- Bilingual (Spanish-speaking) preferred
- Ability to be culturally sensitive and appropriate
- Successful completion of limited criminal history check
- Reliable transportation and valid Indiana driver's license
- Successful completion of BMV check which indicates an unrestricted driver's license with no more than three moving traffic violations, and no major violations, (i.e., those which assign six or more points with the State Motor Vehicle Record Office) within three years prior to date of hire or date of records check
- Proof of automobile insurance of a combined single limit of \$300,000, split limit bodily injury of \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per occurrence, and property damage of \$25,000
